her enthusiastic parents who are both golfers. Her father gave her a set of golf clubs when she was only five years old. At thirteen, she told him she wanted to take up golf as an occupation. Just one year later, she won the world golf junior championship and went on to become the top amateur player in her country. She finally started playing in professional tournaments when she was eighteen years old, and then her career really took off.

The girl, who came second behind her at the British Open for women in two thousand eleven, calls her unbelievable. She says she is so mentally strong, aggressive and confident. She has just got it all. It is pretty cool to watch.

She was not always so confident, especially off the golf course. When she first left her home to start playing in international tournaments, she did not speak English very well. She struggled to communicate with other golfers and had to use an interpreter for interviews. Because she was shy about her English, she had a reputation as a very quiet person.
